Due to the spike in reported cases of COVID-19 Harbor Transit will remain on "Limited Service" until Michigan is placed in the Stage 6 category by Order of the Governor. Harbor Transit will abide by the present Order and continue the mandate of six feet of social distancing.

To comply with the guidelines, Harbor Transit vehicles can accommodate three passengers onboard a bus at one time, due to seating capacity. The two 32 foot buses can accommodate six passengers and still practice social distancing. However, to stay in compliance we will not have the ability to provide service to students for 17 area schools as practiced prior to the COVID-19 breakout. Although the Public Schools are exempt from the Order, Public Transportation is not.

We apologize for any burden this may place upon students and families at this time, but we have to adhere to the Order not only for the safety of the riding public but also for the safety of our drivers and support staff. Harbor Transit is looking forward to returning to normal operating procedures, so we may continue to provide safe, reliable and cost efficient service to ALL.
